

## Access regulations digitalBAU 2022 your secure trade fair visit

### 1. Principles

The hygiene and health protection measures listed below are based on the three primary protection goals and also apply where no explicit regulations are made:

- Adherence to minimum distances (including through design and organizational measures).
- Compliance with hygiene rules (e.g. by the obligation to wear a mask covering the mouth and nose)



### 2. Your visit to the fair

#### A. Arrival

1. if you arrive by public transport, the applicable regulations for local public transport will apply.
2. there is a parking concept for those arriving by car. This concept provides sufficient parking space and is adapted to the special requirements of high traffic volumes.

#### B. Access to the exhibition grounds according to the 3G principle

1. this means that all fair participants have three options for access to the fairgrounds:

Fully **Vaccinated** (minimum 14 days).

**Recovered** (minimum 28 days and maximum six months)

Negatively **Tested** (the test result for PCR- and antigen tests must not be older than 24 hours).

Every trade fair participant who wishes to enter the trade fair grounds during the set-up and dismantling periods as well as the trade fair runtime (organizer, exhibitor, visitor, service provider, etc.) must present appropriate verified digital proof that complies with the Covid digital certificate (EU-DCC standard).

For non-EU citizens without access to the EU-DCC proof, the exception listed on the following page applies.

### 3G: Vaccinated - Recovered - Tested

#### **Status "Vaccinated"**

There must have been a complete vaccination with a vaccine listed by the Paul-Ehrlich-Institut, at least 14 days ago. Complete vaccination means that the second dose has also been administered, provided that two doses are scheduled for a vaccine. Vaccines approved in the EU are permitted. The EU Commission has approved four vaccines to date: BioNTech/Pfizer, Moderna, Astra-Zeneca and Janssen Pharmaceutica NV (Johnson and Johnson). Foreign-approved versions of EU-approved vaccines (original or licensed products) are also recognized. More information is listed here. If a person has been vaccinated with another vaccine, he/she will be treated as an unvaccinated person and must therefore present a negative, up-to-date test.

#### **Status "Convalescent"**

Infection must have occurred at least 28 days and no more than six months ago. After six months, the convalescent status expires and a negative test result or vaccination is required. If the infection occurred more than six months ago, convalescent vaccinees need only one vaccination to be considered fully vaccinated.

#### **Status "Tested"**

A current, negative test result is required and must be confirmed by an official testing site. The test result must not be older than 24 hours (PCR- and antigen test). This may require a new test if the exhibition grounds are entered on several days.


## 2. For non-EU citizens without access to the EU-DCC certificate

Those arriving from a non-EU country and therefore without access to the digital EU-DCC certificate, but vaccinated with a vaccine approved in the EU, will of course also be granted access to the exhibition grounds. The following proofs are possible:

- Fair participants who have been vaccinated with a vaccine approved in the EU or convalescents (at least 28 days, maximum 6 months gene-sen) will be granted access with the written proof with which entry to Germany was also possible.
- To check the documents, we recommend that you set up a special counter in the entrance area and present proof of identity.

- Trade fair participants who enter Germany with a negative test certificate must still present an PCR or antigen test (NOT a self-test) that is no more than 24 hours old, ideally in the EU DCC standard or, if applicable, as a printout from the test center, when entering the trade fair grounds.

#### What do the fair participants need?

1. verified EU DCC code in 3G verification app
2. identity document
3. valid ticket for the event
